Patient Documents Endpoints:

Please note: All dates listed (creation times, sign dates, date of service, update-times) are listed in UTC, so you'll want to adjust **for your local timezone**.

1. Get All Documents for a Patient

Endpoint: /v1/patients/:patient_id/documents

Method: GET

Arguments:

- limit: (optional) defaults to 100, but can be overridden (max is 100)
- offset: (optional) If the returned data indicates that there are more responses than the limit (`has_more: true`), then it will offset the list to allow you to cycle through documents.
- folder: (optional) String (folder name). Limits results to a specific folder or "tab."

Sample Call:

```
curl -X GET "https://un:pwd@subdomain.md-hq.com/api/v1/patients/2/documents"
```

2. Get a single document by document ID

Endpoint: /v1/documents/:document_id

Method: GET

Arguments:

- None

Sample Call:

```
curl -X GET https://un:pwd@subdomain.md-hq.com/api/v1/documents/4225
```

3. Get the binary or raw file data by document ID

Endpoint: /v1/documents/:document_id/content

Method: GET

Arguments:

- None

Sample Call:

```
curl -X GET https://un:pwd@subdomain.md-hq.com/api/v1/documents/1337/content
```

4. Stream the binary or raw file data by document ID

Endpoint: /v1/documents/:document_id/stream

Method: GET

Arguments:

- None

Sample Call:

```
curl -X GET https://un:pwd@subdomain.md-hq.com/api/v1/documents/1337/stream
```

5. Add a document via the portal queue

Endpoint: /v1/patients/:patient_id/documents

Method: POST

Arguments:

- enqueue: (true by default) If true, the system will insert the document into the active patient portal queue so that the clinic is notified and can review the proposed addition.

Data:

- pt_id: (required) An integer identifier for the patient associated with the document.
- mime_type: (required) A string indicating the MIME type of the file. Valid MIME types are listed below.
- name: (required) A string to be used as the title of the document.
- base64_content: (required) Binary data, encoded base64. *Maximum file size is 16MB.*
- notes: (optional) A string.

Sample Call:

```
curl --data '{"pt_id":"1", "mime_type":"image/png", "name":"UltrasoundImage042219",
"notes":"Scanned April 22, 2019 at Acme Imaging Lab", "base64_content":"...."}'-X POST

```
